

PROFILE OF DR. NADADUR JANARDHAN

Dr. Janardhan is the Founder Chairman of Haselfre Health & Wellness Group that focuses on the Quality of Life of Citizens; a role that he enjoys, living constantly in the present. It offers a broad spectrum of services from Pregnant women to have 'defect free babies'; initiatives for children to improve the 'Executive Functions of the Brain' for learning and life; and Haselfre PACT - a special behavioral initiative of this organization that has been conducted for more than 2000 participants in the last one year alone. It is well known for using non-meditational techniques (with 13 IPRs on various issues of behavioural and social psychology) and is the only organization that is allowed by elite organizations such as the Indian Air Force to manage stress of its staff.

He was the youngest Adviser of the United Nations, advising more than 50 countries of Asia and the Pacific on issues relating to Development, Environment and Toxicity and Governance.

He has advised Government of India in introducing massive e-Governance projects such as MCA 21 wherein more than 600,000 companies interact electronically for 72 services of the Government; modernising educational institutions such as Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) and University grants commission (UGC) that are pivotal for Higher Education in India; and crafting new institutions such as National Institute for Smart government (NISG) and UCC/EAN India for rethinking governance both by the Public and private sector. For his efforts, Dr. Janardhan was made the UNESCO Chair Professor of IGNOU on Governance.

Dr. Janardhan is also the Honorary Adviser to the Indian Red Cross Society. His book on "Speed and Certainty in Order Fulfilment" is a compulsory reading text for the Post Graduate students of Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT), for which he was made 'Honorary Fellow of IIFT'.

Dr. Janardhan holds inter-disciplinary educational qualifications, having done his Masters degree in Physics; Doctorate in Economics, focusing on the 'right mix of policies for India (Fiscal, Monetary, Trade and Environment)' and specialization on Behavioural and Social Psychology.
